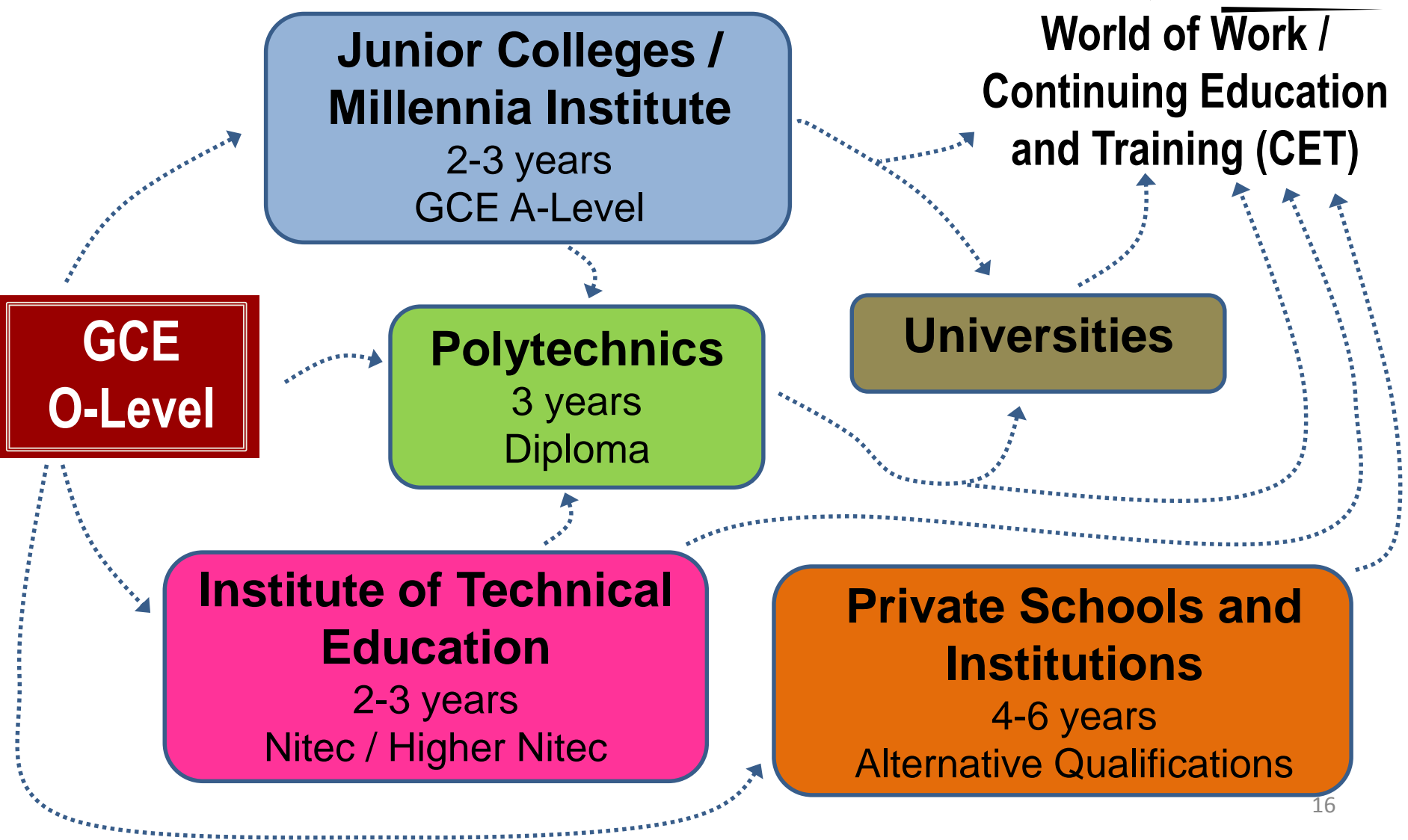

Relevant Subject 4 - Any GCE 'O' Level subjects

NOTE ON MERGER OF JCs



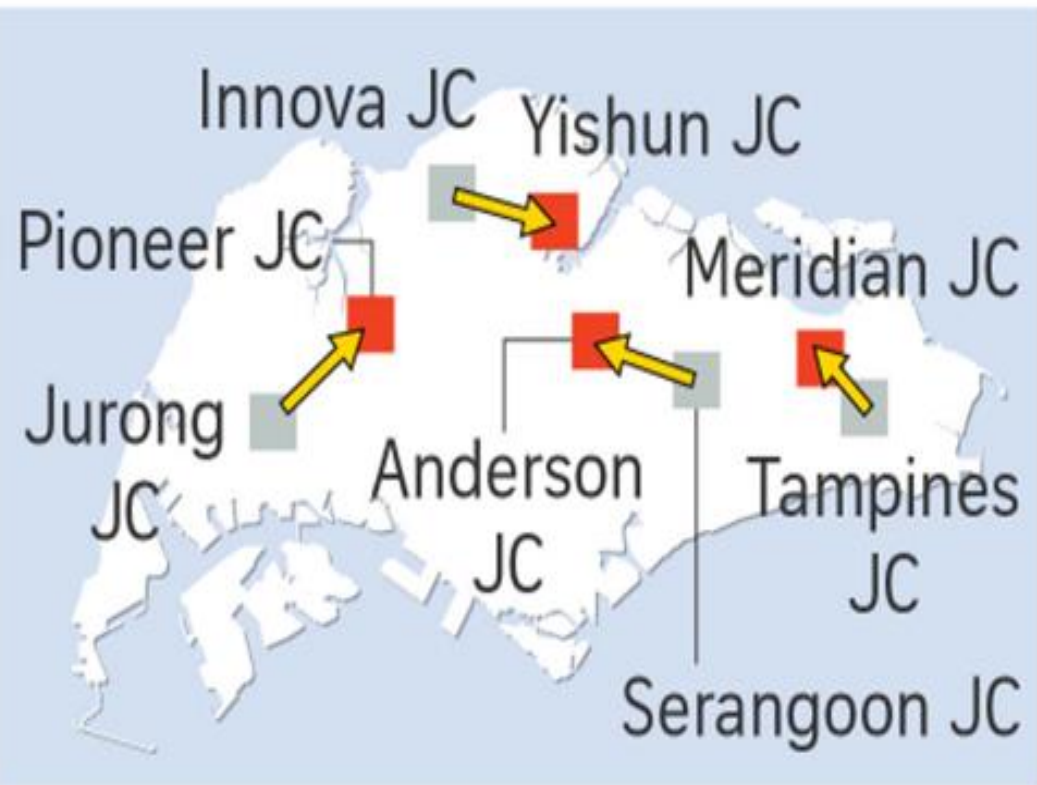
