- Students who are offered AsL/FL as MTL in-lieu at Primary level will continue to offer the language at Secondary level.
- Students are required to learn the AsL/FL privately at the Secondary and Preuniversity levels, as instruction is not provided by MOE.
  - Students are required to provide documentation to the school to indicate that they are learning AL/FL regularly.
  - Sec1 FL students who would like to be on the waiting list to be considered for admission to the MOE Language Centre (MOELC) may submit application through our school.
    - There are limited vacancies at MOELC. Please proceed to General Office to obtain an application form.
      - (Only when application is successful) Students will be informed through school to sit for a readiness test. Admission to MOELC is subject to passing the test.
      - Students who have not been notified to sit for the readiness test or did not pass the test are required to continue with their private study arrangements.
- All students taking MTL in-lieu will do self-directed learning in their Form Class during MTL periods in our school.
- Please note the **important differences** between MTL in-lieu at Primary and Secondary level:

AsL/FL grade is not a requirement for admission into Secondary school.	<ul> <li>Students are required to attain the minimum AsL/FL grade for admission into</li> <li>✓ a junior college or centralised institute (D7 or above at SEC),</li> <li>✓ or a local publicly-funded undergraduate programme (S grade or above at GCE A Level H1).</li> <li>This requirement is the same as other MTL, as AsL/FL is regarded as the MTL of your child/ward.</li> </ul>

# 5. Exemption from Mother Tongue Language

- Students who have been exempted from MTL at Primary Level will continue to be exempted from MTL at Secondary level. No action is required.
- Students exempted from MTL will do self-directed learning in their Form Class during MTL periods.
